

FAECAL OCCULT BLOOD

The collection container is provided free of charge at the blood collection centres upon presentation of a medical prescription.

COLLECTION INSTRUCTION

- The purpose of the test is to detect the possible presence of blood in the stool, which is a common symptom of numerous diseases.
- It is not necessary to follow any specific diet before the test.
- Do not perform the test during menstruation or when suffering from haemorrhoids.
- Avoid contaminating the stool with urine.
- It is recommended to place a layer of toilet paper in the toilet to catch the stool for the time needed to collect the sample.

Carefully follow the instructions listed below:



1. UNSCREW AND REMOVE THE GREEN CAP FROM THE TUBE AND WRITE THE REQUIRED INFORMATION ON THE LABEL.

- 2. SWIPE THE STICK OVER THE FECES MULTIPLE TIMES HORIZONTALLY AND VERTICALLY.
- 3. INSERT THE STICK INTO THE TUBE, SCREW IT BACK ON AND SHAKE.

It is advisable to collect a sample in the early morning and deliver it the same day. Otherwise, store the sample in the refrigerator (do not freeze) and deliver it the next morning. If <u>3 samples</u> are prescribed, collect the samples on different days (3 consecutive days, or within 5 days), store them in the refrigerator, and deliver them all together.
