URINE CULTURE FROM PERMANENT CATHETER

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(Urine culture test from a permanent catheter)

The sample collection must take place on the morning of the delivery day.

- 1. <u>Collect the urine sterilely in a wide-mouth sterile container for urine culture.</u> <u>Do not collect urine from the bag.</u>
 - wash thoroughly your hands with soap (not disinfectants) and dry them.
 - detach the bag from the catheter and close the catheter tube with the appropriate sterile cap. Disinfect the connection between the catheter and the cap.
 - remove the cap, discard the first few drops of urine, let the urine flow directly into a sterile container for urine culture, being careful not to overfill it. Close the container immediately.
 - reconnect the catheter-bag connection.
 - deliver to the Blood collection centre on the same day of the collection
- 2. If provided with a Uriswab swab from the Blood collection centre, after urine collection:
 - open the screw cap of the Uriswab tube without touching the sterile sponge
 - immerse the sponge for 10 seconds in the urine collected in the sterile urine culture container until the sponge is saturated
 - reinsert the sponge into the tube and securely close the screw cap. Deliver the Uriswab tube to the Blood collection centre.



NOTE: Do NOT fill the Uriswab tube with urine

NOTE: if using the same urine sample (single sterile container) for urine culture and chemicalphysical urine examination, <u>first</u> perform the collection with the Uriswab swab for urine culture, <u>then</u> transfer the urine into the test tube for the urine examination.

The sterile container + Uriswab swab are provided free of charge at the Blood collection centre upon presentation of a medical prescription. Alternatively, the wide-mouth sterile container can be purchased externally, e.g., in a pharmacy.
